PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN DURING FY 2016-17

During the year 2016-17, the Company has undertaken numerous initiatives towards CSR & Sustainability activities in the field of public health, facilities for elderly and differently abled persons, sanitation & cleanliness. Some significant CSR & Sustainability activities undertaken by the company during the year are:

i. Construction of NAMMA toilets:

Modular type NAMMA toilets were provided at Agra, Gorakhpur, Gwalior, Jaipur and Vadodara railway stations under CSR initiative of IRCTC. The sanctioned cost of project is 1,25,00,000/- out of which 60,65,000/- was spent in FY 2016-17.



ii. Medical Equipments for AIIMS, New Delhi:

IRCTC supplied medical equipments including 02 Intensive Care Ventilators, 70 wheel chairs and 30 patient trolleys to Jai Prakash Narayan Apex Trauma Centre, AIIMS, New Delhi and Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Institute Rotary Cancer Hospital, AIIMS, New Delhi.

iii. PET Bottle Crusher at railway station:

A pet bottle crusher machine was provided at Kacheguda Railway Station at a total cost of $\gtrless 1,90,757/-$.

iv. Operation of golf carts for elderly persons, differently abled persons at railway premises and provision of water vending machine: IRCTC took initiative to operate golf carts at railway stations to assist the elderly and differently abled persons at railway premises. The

the elderly and differently abled persons at railway premises. The Company also provided Water Vending Machine at Thane Municipal Corporation.



v. Renovation of toilet blocks at Varanasi and Provision of a toilet block at Gazipur Railway Station:

For up gradation of passenger amenities, toilets blocks at Varanasi station was renovated with total cost of ₹10,11,174/- and one toilet block was provided at Ghazipur railway station at a total cost of ₹3,97,125/-.

vi. Allotment of 33% of Total CSR funds towards Swachh Bharat Activities:

In accordance with Department of Public Enterprise (DPE) guidelines regarding "Allocation of CSR funds by CPSE for Swachh Bharat Activities", IRCTC allotted 33% of the total CSR funds amounting to ₹1,50,00,000/- towards "Swachh Bharat Kosh set up by the Central Government.

vii. Adoption of needy cancer patients through Cancer Patient Aid Association (CPAA) and Health Minister's Cancer Patient Fund:

The Company contributed of $\gtrless10,00,000/$ - to Cancer Patient Aid Association (CPAA) towards adoption of needy cancer patients and of $\gtrless1,81,33,841/$ - to Health Minister's Cancer Patient Fund.
